A public hearing will be conducted by the Civil Service Commission pursuant to § 26-12(C) of the City of St. Francis Code of Ordinances on **Thursday, April 30, 2015 beginning at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 3400 E. Howard Avenue, St. Francis. You are hereby notified that, at the conclusion of any closed session, the Civil Service Commission may reconvene into open session for possible additional discussion and action concerning any matter discussed in closed session and for adjournment of the meeting.

2. Public Hearing—Steve Dimoff .
 - A. Public Hearing pursuant to § 26-12(C) of the City of St. Francis Code of Ordinances concerning request by Steve Dimoff under § 26-12(B) of the City of St. Francis Code of Ordinances for Civil Service Commission review of April 7, 2015 termination letter. Motions may be made from time-to-time during the course of the hearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.85(1)(a) and/or 19.85(1)(g) to allow the Civil Service Commission to deliberate on a particular matter before it and/or to consult with legal counsel concerning a matter that the Civil Service Commission is, or is likely to become involved, in litigation. Upon conclusion of any such closed session, the Commission will reconvene into open session for action on matters discussed in closed session and to resume the hearing.
 - B. Deliberations. Upon conclusion of the hearing referred to in paragraph 2(A) above, a motion may be made to allow the Civil Service Commission to enter into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 19.85(1)(a) for purposes of deliberations concerning the quasi-judicial hearing or case before it.
 - C. Upon conclusion of closed session deliberations, the Commission will reconvene into open session to announce the Commission's determination and, if necessary to discuss scheduling and administrative issues concerning any further proceedings.
3. Adjournment.
