

2015 Trash and Recycling Schedule

Waste Management will continue to collect trash weekly on your regularly scheduled day. Be sure to have your trash at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. Waste Management will also collect recycling on the same day as your trash collection, every other week as indicated by the grey weeks on the adjacent calendar.

Holidays

Waste and recycling collection service will be delayed one day if a holiday falls on or before your collection day. For example, Wednesday customers will be serviced on Thursday.

Memorial Day - Monday May 25, 2015

Labor Day - Monday September 7, 2015

Thanksgiving Day - Thursday, November 26, 2015

Christmas Day - Wednesday, December 25, 2015

New Year's Day - Friday, January 1, 2016

Curbside Timing

Please have your cart at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection. Please do not place any carts near your mailbox and allow at least two feet between the carts if possible.

Missed Collections

Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us as soon as you can. We'll try to return on the same day to pick it up, without charge. If our driver has already left the City of St. Francis, we'll pick up the missed stop the following day.

THINK GREEN®

Dear St. Francis Resident;

Starting in March of 2015, Waste Management will begin providing automated garbage collection, and continue with automated recycling collection services. We look forward to helping St. Francis be as clean – and green – as possible throughout 2015 and beyond.

Making the transition from your current waste service to automated service will be simple. Here are a few things to keep in mind:

New Cart

Each residence will receive a 96 – gallon green waste cart that will be collected weekly. Residents will also receive a 96 – gallon blue cart for recycling that will be collected every other week. New carts will be delivered any day between March 2 and March 13. Beginning Monday, March 16, 2015, only new carts will be serviced. Please place only waste in the green cart and acceptable recyclable materials in the blue cart not to exceed 200 pounds per cart.

Waste Collection

Your garbage collection day will remain the same as it currently is and will be collected weekly. Remember that all garbage must fit inside the green cart – any items outside the cart will not be collected and must be removed from the curb, unless it is a Bulk Collection Day – which takes place the last week of each month.

Bulk Item Collection

Large, bulky items, will be picked up on the fourth regular collection week of the month. For example, if your collection day is Tuesday and you have a couch to dispose of, you can put the couch out on the fourth Tuesday of the month for pick-up. Bulk items are items that do not fit in the cart like mattresses, furniture, small rolls of carpet, lumber, Christmas trees, etc. Bulk items do not include large appliances, electronics and white goods, large auto parts, tree trimmings, concrete, brick, roofing, etc.

Recycling Collection

Your recycling collection day will remain the same and continue to be collected every other week. Please see the adjacent panel to learn how St. Francis residents can use the Recycle Often. Recycle RightSM program. Beginning March 16, only the new blue recycling carts will be collected. If you currently have a gray or green recycling cart, you may keep it for your own use, but it cannot be used for recycling collection on or after March 16, 2015.

Old Recycling Carts

Should you not want your old recycling carts, put them at the curb and they will be collected during the week of March 16 - March 20.

Hazardous Items

Waste Management will not collect solid or liquid hazardous waste. Examples include liquid paint, oil based paint, petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents, and explosive items. When the City of St. Francis residents use **Recycle Often. Recycle RightSM**, great things happen. By recycling everyday items like those shown below, tons of raw materials, time, energy and money are saved. Plus the recycled materials become new products – if you recycle an aluminum can today, it could be back on the shelf as a new one in 60 days – and the cycle continues.

- Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below together in your blue recycling cart – no sorting needed.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Do not put recyclables in plastic bags.

Recycling will be collected every other week – see the calendar on the back side to determine your Recycling Collection Week. Acceptable materials for curbside recycling include:

(Keep medical waste out of recycling. Place in safe disposal containers like Waste Management's MedWaste Tracker[®] box.)
