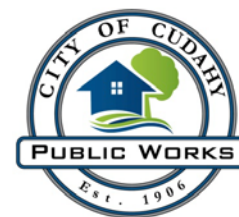




PACKARD AVENUE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN SOON



The full road reconstruction of Packard Avenue between Cudahy Avenue and Lunham Avenue is expected to begin June 5th. Although property owners on Packard Avenue in Cudahy have received information about the project, we are also including property owners within a block of the project and along the detour route to get them better acquainted with the road closures, parking, and the detour route. This is typical for projects of this magnitude. The City of Cudahy met with the Contractor in order to finalize the schedule and coordinate efforts with the School Districts, the City of St. Francis, and Milwaukee County Transit. The following summarizes the latest information.

- **Schedule:** Vinton Construction Company was awarded the bid for the Packard Avenue reconstruction project. They plan to start work on **Monday June 5th** and, weather pending, expect to be finished the week of **August 21st**. This means that the detour and barricading will be set up starting on June 5th.
- **Closures & Detour Route:** The detour route will again be on Kingan Avenue from Plankinton Ave to Plainfield Ave. in St. Francis. Allerton and Lunham Avenue will remain open for cross traffic during the week of June 5th until school is out. Starting June 12th, Packard Avenue will be completely closed, including the intersections of Allerton and Lunham. A map of the detour has been attached.
- **The Milwaukee County Transit Bus route will be relocated to the dedicated detour route.** Please watch for signs noting bus stop and route changes.
- **Alleys are not meant to be used as detour routes.** Local traffic shall follow the posted detour routes along the side streets. The alleys are to be used only as access for property owners that live along the alley and for garbage and recycling pick up. Because the alley is a public right of way, the City cannot limit use of the alley by the public. However, vehicles due have to abide by traffic laws.
- **S. Kingan Ave. from E. Plankinton Ave. to E. Lunham Ave. will be posted NO PARKING along both sides of the street.** This street will be a dedicated detour route for duration of the project which necessitates a wider roadway width, therefore parking cannot be accommodated. The Residents that park on these blocks, shall use nearby blocks for overflow parking. Police department odd/even night parking restrictions still apply for surrounding blocks, unless noted otherwise. E. Plainfield Avenue from S. Kingan Ave. to S. Packard Ave. will be posted NO PARKING along the north side of the street during the project. This is to facilitate the bus detour. Buses are anticipated twice per day.
- **PARKING:** Because of the work on Packard Avenue, property owners that live along Packard in Cudahy will have no parking available to them on Packard Avenue during the next several months. In addition parking will not be available on the detour route – Kingan Avenue in Cudahy. This will require residents who normally park on these roadways to park on the side streets which will limit parking availability to all residents. Please be understanding.
