Chairman Wattawa called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

Moved by Alderman Brickner, seconded by Alderman Drew to place on file the minutes of the Bargaining Committee meeting held January 21, 2020. Motion carried.

City Administrator Johnsrud explained the need for a Plumbing Inspector at this time. Our Building Inspector will be taking the exam in April, so this position will be temporary. It is estimated that he will work 6 – 10 hours per work, and mainly on the Campbell Development.

Moved by Alderman Drew, seconded by Alderman Brickner to recommend to the Common Council the temporary employment of Mark Krowski as the Plumbing Inspector. Motion carried.
