Did You Know?

The Lakefront Power Plant once stood on the site of the current Park Shore Condominiums? The City of St. Francis and the DNR with the Army Corps of Engineers allowed filling and reclamation of 23 acres of eroded shoreline. The 23-acre erosion control project was donated by the developer of Park Shore at no cost to the taxpayers. The land was then donated to the County for the Oak Leaf Trail and access was provided to the public.
