ORDINANCE NO. 1511

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION 435-11(A)  
OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS CODE OF ORDINANCES  
AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS  
IN THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS**

WHEREAS, Section 349.07(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that the governing body of any town, city, village or county may by ordinance or resolution provide for the installation of stop signs and traffic signals at intersections on highways over which it has exclusive jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Section 435-11(A) of the City of St. Francis Code of Ordinances provides for the placement of stop signs at certain specified locations on City highways and streets within the City of St. Francis controlling all directions of travel; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works of the City of St. Francis has recommended the placement of additional all-way stop signs as set forth in this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that reorganization of the existing provisions of Section 435-11(A) will aide in the future application of that section; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that the establishment of the aforementioned recommended stop signs will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of St. Francis, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 435, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”; Section 435-11(A), entitled “All-Way Stop Signs”; is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

**§ 435-11. Stop signs.**

A. All-Way Stop Signs. In the interest of public safety, stop signs for all directions of travel shall be erected at the following intersections:

- (1) East Allerton Avenue and South Illinois Avenue.
- (2) East Armour Avenue and South Illinois Avenue.
- (3) East Bottsford Avenue and South Illinois Avenue.
- (4) East Elizabeth Avenue and South Iowa Avenue.
- (5) East Howard Avenue and South Iowa Avenue.
- (6) East Howard Avenue and South Packard Avenue.
- (7) East Norwich Avenue and South Iowa Avenue.
- (8) East Norwich Avenue and South Kansas Avenue.

- (9) East Norwich Avenue and South Nevada Avenue.
- (10) East St. Francis Avenue and South Iowa Avenue.
- (11) East Tesch Avenue and South Kingan Avenue.
- ~~(11)~~(12) East Tesch Avenue and South Kirkwood Avenue
- ~~(12)~~(13) East Van Norman Avenue and South Delaware Avenue.
- ~~(13)~~(14) East Van Norman Avenue and South Illinois Avenue.
- ~~(14)~~(15) East Waterford Avenue at South Barland Avenue.

**SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.**

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
