

## MINUTES OF THE BARGAINING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD MAY 2, 2023

- Civic Center Summer Hours

A survey was attached for the Committee to review. City Administrator Johnsrud discussed that hours would be Monday – Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. to Noon on Friday. It would give residents an opportunity to be able to come in to the Civic Center earlier. He stated that many communities are looking at changing hours to be more efficient. The suggestion would be to try it this summer (Memorial Day – Labor Day) and see if there are any issues. Chairwoman Fliss did call several surrounding communities and most are not changing hours. This was discussed with staff and they were agreeable to the proposed hours. There would be no change in the hourly work week, just a change in the hours. Chairwoman Fliss was concerned about the perception of the residents would be with the Civic Center being closed Friday afternoons. Alderman Brickner felt that City Hall was an essential place to work and people would expect it to be open. City Administrator Johnsrud also said that Friday afternoons are typically very slow. Building Inspector and Engineering would be on the same schedule. The DPW would stay on their same schedule of Monday – Friday. Alderman Wattawa would feel more comfortable if there would be staff here all day on Friday.

The consensus of the Committee was to leave the hours as they are.
