

## MINUTES OF THE LICENSE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 6, 2022

Chairman Brickner called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m.

### **Minutes:**

Moved by Alderman Damon, seconded by Alderman Wattawa to place on file the minutes of the License Committee meeting held August 16, 2022. Motion carried.

### **Licenses:**

Moved by Alderman Wattawa, seconded by Alderman Damon to recommend approval of a Beverage Operator's License – New for Mya Roberts. Motion carried.

Moved by Alderman Damon, seconded by Alderman Wattawa to recommend approval of an Outdoor Cabaret License for Faklandia Brewing – Ben Mantay at 3807 South Packard Avenue for the Made in Nerdwaukee event to be held October 8, 2022 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Motion carried.

### **Temporary Extension of "Class B" Premise:**

Faklandia Brewing has requested an extension of premise for the Made in Nerdwaukee event. The extension would be directly in front of Faklandia on Packard Avenue pending approval of the street closure application that is on the Common Council agenda. They would like to also have a 30 X 90 foot tent erected on Packard Avenue as well.

Chief Hunter spoke with Mr. Mantay and shared his concerns regarding the street closing as it relates to safety. Chief Hunter would only allow jersey barriers in the street. Alderman Damon asked if employees could use their personal vehicles to block the street off. Chief Hunter stated that signage would still be needed regarding the street closure.

City Administrator Johnsrud questioned where all the patrons would park since the predicted turnout is over 700. Sivyer Avenue can't be blocked off and having cars packed up and down both sides of the street will be an issue for the residents on Sivyer. The Triangle Property is mostly grass and isn't conducive to use as a parking lot.

City Engineer Dejewski stated that if they would like to have a tent on the property south of their building, WE Energies would have to be contacted for approval. She suggested that Vretenar Park could be an option as it holds the amount of people they are looking at with a pavilion as well as the band shell.

Alderman Wattawa stated he did not like the idea of a tent in the street. Mr. Mantay stated that they could put the tent in their parking lot. City Attorney Alexy didn't know where the extension of premise would be as it will depend on where the tent would be located.

Moved by Alderman Damon, seconded by Alderman Wattawa to refer the Temporary Extension of "Class B" License for Faklandia to the next License Committee agenda. Motion carried.
