Tavern Violation: Neighborhood Bar – 4607 South Whitnall Avenue:

Discussion was held regarding the violations at the Neighborhood Bar. City Attorney Alexy stated that this is the third violation in a 12 month period. They include an after-hours violation; changing the business/bar name without notifying the City or amending the liquor license to reflect the change; and two Health Department violations.

Moved by Alderman Damon, seconded by Alderman Wattawa to set a hearing for May 17, 2022 for the intent to deny renewal of the Combination Class B retail alcohol license issued to Neighborhood Works, LLC d/b/a "The Neighborhood Bar" located at 4607 South Whitnall Avenue. Motion carried.
